Eligibility	: The following types of enterprise* engaged in the manufacture or production of goods are eligible to apply:
	» <b>Micro enterprise</b> – where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed Rs.1 crore and Annual Turnover does not exceed Rs. 5 crore.
	» <b>Small enterprise</b> – where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed Rs.10 crore and Annual Turnover does not exceed Rs. 50 crore.
	» <b>Medium enterprise</b> – where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed Rs.50 crore and Annual Turnover does not exceed Rs. 250 crore and which has filed Memorandum with the District Industries Centre as required under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006.
	<b>Note:</b> While calculating the investment in Plant and Machinery, the cost of pollution control, research and development, industrial safety devices shall be excluded.

## **SERVICE SECTOR**

Eligibility

- : The following Establishments are eligible to apply:
- 1. Hotels having more than 100 rooms or 15 m height and above.
- 2. IT establishments having high rise buildings (15 m heights & above) or floor area above  $1,000 \text{ m}^2$ .
- 3. Hospitals having 100 or more beds or 15 m height and above.
- 4. Electricity Transmission line/distribution line (11 KV above) Station.
- 5. Corporate/Bank/Insurance offices located in high rise buildings (15 m heights & above) or floor area above  $1,000 \text{ m}^2$ .
- 6. R & D Centre employing more than 100 employees (Independent centre not covered in the Factories Act, 1948).
- 7. Warehouses having floor area above  $10,000 \text{ m}^2$ .
- 8. Airport operation (Ground activities managed by airport owner/operator).
- 9. Shopping Mall (Activities managed by Owner/ Operator) having floor area above 50,000 m<sup>2</sup>.
- 10. Ports (Major port and Non-Major Ports (minor ports).

The above establishment shall be registered under the Shop & Establishment Act (registered premise only) or any other applicable statute.

The establishment should be in operation for a minimum of 3 years period before the awards year.

Awards Year : Calendar Year-2023.

Assessment Period: One calendar year (2022) previous to the Awards Year-2023.

# HOW TO APPLY

- The Application Form is available for free download on NSC website at https://nsc.org.in/safety-awards/
- Read carefully the Rules & Regulations and Instructions for filling-up & submission of the application form.
- The Application Form shall be submitted online. Under exceptional circumstances, offline submission will be accepted with the additional processing fee of Rs. 3,000/-. It is advisable to submit it online as an environment protection initiative.
  - Online Submission:

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- i) Make online request along with the payment details (Online/NEFT/RTGS or Demand Draft) available at the NSC Website.
- ii) You will receive a user ID and password to access the NSCI Digital portal for filling up and submitting the application form.
- Offline submission:
  - Send the filled-in Application Form (one hard copy and one soft copy in pen-drive/DVD) along with a payment in the form of Demand Draft towards a processing fee. If payment made by Online/NEFT/ RTGS/ BANK transfer, provide its details at the space provided in the Application Form.
  - ii) The filled-in Application Form can be sent by post/ courier or hand delivery at National safety Council, Plot No. 98-A, Sector-15, CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai-400614.
- Last date for receiving the application in NSC is **30<sup>th</sup> June**, **2023**.
- Mode of Payment

# UNIQUE FEATURES OF NSCI SAFETY AWARDS

- The Assessment criteria are objective, comprehensive, and rigorous and take into consideration of sustained performance over three years for manufacturing sector, one year for construction sector, two years for MSME Sector and one year for Service Sector previous to the Award Year.
- To demonstrate the commitment and team work, the application form for manufacturing sector to be signed by the Chairman of the Apex Safety Committee and Worker's representative on the Apex Safety Committee. In Construction sector, it should be signed by the In-charge of the establishment and authorized representative of the client organization. Whereas, for MSME sector the form to be signed by Owner/Entrepreneur/Occupier along with Worker's representative and for Service sector the form to be signed by Owner/Employer.
- To recognise the team work involved in achieving the award winning performance, each organization is requested to send a 3-member team comprising the Unit Head/Project Head, Safety Head and a Senior Worker-member on the Safety Committee for receiving the award.
- In construction sector, the client organistions are also conferred along with the establishments to recognize their contribution in the achievement.
