MANUFACTURING SECTOR

- Eligibility** : Factory registered under the Factories Act, 1948 and manufacturing activity commenced before the assessment period.
- Awards Year** : Calendar Year-2023.
- Assessment Period** : Three calendar years (2020, 2021 and 2022) previous to the Awards Year-2023.
- Categories** : The industrial undertakings (Manufacturing Sector) are categorised in six groups for the Award purpose as follows:

CONSTRUCTION SECTOR

Eligibility

: Any establishment or contractor “registered under the Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996 [BOCW (RECS) Act, 1996] **or** under the Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 [CL(R&A) Act, 1970] **or** licensed under CL(R&A) Act, 1970” for executing “building and other construction work” as defined under the BOCW (RECS) Act, 1996 and employed 100 **or** more building workers in the project for at least 240 days during assessment period.

OR

Any Project Management Consultant (PMC), whose client or their contractors registered under BOCW (RECS) Act., 1996 **or** CL(R&A) Act, 1970 **or** licensed under CL(R&A) Act, 1970 for executing “building and other construction work” as defined under the BOCW (RECS) Act, 1996 and employed 100 **or** more building workers in the project for at least 240 days during assessment period.

Awards Year

: Calendar year – 2023.

Assessment Period

: One calendar year (2022) previous to the Awards Year-2023.

Categories

: The Construction activities are categorized in two groups for the Award purpose as follows:

Group	Nature of Construction Activity
A) Buildings	Residential, Commercial (Educational, Hospital, Malls, Offices, Hotel, IT Hub etc.)
B) Non- Buildings	Streets, Roads, Railways, Tramways, Airfields, Irrigation, Drainage, Embarkment & Navigation Work, Flood Control Work, Generation, Transmission and Distribution of Power, Water Work, Oil & Gas Installation, Electric lines, Wireless, radio, television, telephone, telegraph and overseas communication, Dams, canals, reservoirs, watercourses, Tunnels, Bridges, Viaduct, Aquaducts, Pipelines, Towers, Cooling towers, Transmission towers, Factory, any other not covered above.

MSME SECTOR (Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises)

Eligibility

- The following types of enterprise* engaged in the manufacture or production of goods are eligible to apply:
- » **Micro enterprise** – where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed Rs.1 crore and Annual Turnover does not exceed Rs. 5 crore.
- » **Small enterprise** – where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed Rs.10 crore and Annual Turnover does not exceed Rs. 50 crore.
- » **Medium enterprise** – where the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed Rs.50 crore and Annual Turnover does not exceed Rs. 250 crore and which has filed Memorandum with the District Industries Centre as required under the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006.

Note: While calculating the investment in Plant and Machinery, the cost of pollution control, research and development, industrial safety devices shall be excluded.

*As per the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises vide notification No. S.O. 2119(E) dated 26th June, 2020.

- Calendar Year- 2023.

Assessment Period

- Two calendar years previous to the Awards Year-2023(i.e. 2021 and 2022).

SERVICE SECTOR

Eligibility

: The following Establishments are eligible to apply:

1. Hotels having more than 100 rooms or 15 m height and above.
2. IT establishments having high rise buildings (15 m heights & above) or floor area above 1,000 m².
3. Hospitals having 100 or more beds or 15 m height and above.
4. Electricity Transmission line/distribution line (11 KV above) Station.
5. Corporate/Bank/Insurance offices located in high rise buildings (15 m heights & above) or floor area above 1,000 m².
6. R & D Centre employing more than 100 employees (Independent centre not covered in the Factories Act, 1948).
7. Warehouses having floor area above 10,000 m².
8. Airport operation (Ground activities managed by airport owner/operator).
9. Shopping Mall (Activities managed by Owner/ Operator) having floor area above 50,000 m².
10. Ports (Major port and Non-Major Ports (minor ports)).

The above establishment shall be registered under the Shop & Establishment Act (registered premise only) or any other applicable statute.

The establishment should be in operation for a minimum of 3 years period before the awards year.

: Calendar Year-2023.

Assessment Period: One calendar year (2022) previous to the Awards Year-2023.

HOW TO APPLY

- The Application Form is available for free download on NSC website at <https://nsc.org.in/safety-awards/>
- Read carefully the Rules & Regulations and Instructions for filling-up & submission of the application form.
- The Application Form shall be submitted online. Under exceptional circumstances, offline submission will be accepted with the additional processing fee of Rs. 3,000/-. It is advisable to submit it online as an environment protection initiative.
- Online Submission:
 - i) Make online request along with the payment details (Online/NEFT/RTGS or Demand Draft) available at the NSC Website.
 - ii) You will receive a user ID and password to access the NSCI Digital portal for filling up and submitting the application form.
- Offline submission:
 - i) Send the filled-in Application Form (one hard copy and one soft copy in pen-drive/DVD) along with a payment in the form of Demand Draft towards a processing fee. If payment made by Online/NEFT/ RTGS/ BANK transfer, provide its details at the space provided in the Application Form.
 - ii) The filled-in Application Form can be sent by post/ courier or hand delivery at National safety Council, Plot No. 98-A, Sector-15, CBD Belapur, Navi Mumbai – 400614.
- Last date for receiving the application in NSC is **30th June, 2023**.
- Mode of Payment

UNIQUE FEATURES OF NSCI SAFETY AWARDS

- The Assessment criteria are objective, comprehensive, and rigorous and take into consideration of sustained performance over three years for manufacturing sector, one year for construction sector, two years for MSME Sector and one year for Service Sector previous to the Award Year.
- To demonstrate the commitment and team work, the application form for manufacturing sector to be signed by the Chairman of the Apex Safety Committee and Worker's representative on the Apex Safety Committee. In Construction sector, it should be signed by the In-charge of the establishment and authorized representative of the client organization. Whereas, for MSME sector the form to be signed by Owner/Entrepreneur/Occupier along with Worker's representative and for Service sector the form to be signed by Owner/Employer.
- To recognise the team work involved in achieving the award winning performance, each organization is requested to send a 3-member team comprising the Unit Head/Project Head, Safety Head and a Senior Worker-member on the Safety Committee for receiving the award.
- In construction sector, the client organisations are also conferred along with the establishments to recognize their contribution in the achievement.
